Earn CFRE credits for education

Certified Fundraising Executives (CFRE) can earn up to 6 CE credits per day for attending any Blackbaud University Training session. Interested individuals are responsible for tracking each session they attend. 90 minute sessions earn 1.5 CE credit, and 180 minute sessions earn 3 credits.

CFRE International offers the only internationally recognized baseline professional credential for philanthropic fundraising executives. As stewards of the public trust, Certified Fund Raising Executive (CFRE) International certifies fundraising professionals who demonstrate the knowledge, skills and commitment to the highest standards of ethical and professional practice in serving the philanthropic sector. CFRE International fulfills this mission by establishing and administering a voluntary certification process based on current and valid standards that measure competency in the practice of philanthropic fundraising.

All bbcon 2017 General Sessions and Blackbaud University Day sessions qualify for CFRE credits.

Earn CPE credits for education

As part of our continuing commitment to providing high-quality continuing professional education, Blackbaud is registered sponsor of the National Registry of CPE Sponsors, a program offered by the National Association of State Boards of Accountancy (NASBA). This registry recognizes that our continuing professional education for accountants meets nationally recognized standards.

Accountants are required by state governing boards to earn CPE credits to maintain and enhance their professional competence. As a registered sponsor, the Blackbaud name and address is printed on a registry that is distributed to state boards of accountancy and made available to licensed accountants across the country. Which sessions are eligible for CPE credits?

What is the NASBA field of study?

All Financial Edge and FIMS Learn Lab sessions belong to the Information Technology – Technical field of study.

All Nonprofit Workshop sessions belong to the Business Management & Organization- Non-Technical field of study.

How are the number CPE credits determined?

CPE credits are granted based on 50-minutes of instructional time. Participants are eligible for one CPE credit for all 90 minute eligible sessions, and two CPE credits for 180 minute eligible sessions.
